The Book of James (January-March)

James is one of the most practical, hard-hitting books of the Bible. To James, Christianity was a daily life to be lived. It's been referred to as the "gospel of common sense," the "how-to" book of the Christian life, the "New Testament book of proverbs." The message of James will hurt one's feelings, but at the same time, strengthen one's faith beyond measure.

The Beatitudes (April-June)

The Sermon on the Mount is unquestionably the greatest sermon ever preached. And how Jesus begins this sermon -- with the Beatitudes -- represents God's plan for maximum living; how you and I can find genuine life-fulfillment.

The Sermon on the Mount (July-September)

It is arguably the most remembered sermon of all-time, and Jesus gets to the heart of what it means to walk with God. His message was designed to confront, gain attention, and then ultimately, be a call to action. While it may be the most remembered sermon, how often do we live it? The Sermon on the Mount changed lives then. And it still does today.

Christians in the Workplace (Oct.-Dec.)

Do we see our individual lives consisting of distinct, separate areas: a home life, a social life, a work life, and a church life? Christians must recognize their entire life is to be devoted to Christ, and that they are to be directed by the will of Christ in every phase of that life. Every job and work environment is different, and the goals in this study include how to identify and endeavor to overcome the spiritual challenges of our main vocation, be a more Christ-like example to our co-workers, and make more godly decisions while in the workplace.






